Aim

The overall aim is to give students an opportunity to conduct a specialised design project within a special area of interest.

Learning outcomes

Knowledge and understanding
For a passing grade the student must

- by means of a design project be able to show deepened knowledge within the chosen area of interest.
- have insight in the working procedure in an architectural project.

Competences and skills

For a passing grade the student must

- be able to independently plan, implement and report a designed project within advanced level.
- be able to independently search, retrieve, and compile relevant information in a well communicated manner.

• be able to systematically integrate and use knowledge within the chosen special area of intereste and exhibit this in a designed or written project.

Judgement and approach

For a passing grade the student must

• be able to critically read, evaluate and make use of conclusions from relevant literature or reference examples within the specific area of interest.

Contents

The course content will be determined in a program of study executed in dialogue with the course responsible teacher.

Examination details

Assessment: The design project will be reported and examined in accordance with the guiding principles set up by the course responsible teacher.
