- clearly elaborate art's culture and the aesthetic point of view in technique, colour and form.
- to practice how to communicate ideas and to reflect about the relation between spaces and objects.
- to practice reflection on the material culture of societies.

## Contents

- Exercises in 3-dimensional composition and communication.
- Use of different methods in image creation of spaces and objects.
- Experimental exercises about the relationship between humans, spaces and materials.

The course Visual Communication part II takes a hold on different transformation techniques from an artistic perspective. That is, the course is about transitions from one media to another, or from one aesthetic expression to another. The course contains of a series of workshops that have their starting point in words and graphic shapes, films and spaces, and wearable objects. The different workshops are lead by different teachers and are examined as oral presentations and as short exhibitions.
